Effective July 1, disabled staff, faculty and students at the Davis campus will no longer have to pay for parking as long as they display a valid, DMV-issued disabled person parking placard and a no-cost Disabled (DSA) permit provided by TAPS.

Years ago, the University reduced the cost to disabled individuals for a DSA permit. By ending the practice of charging for DSA permits altogether, our university is demonstrating a commitment to better accommodating individuals that make this a more diverse campus.

I'm incredibly proud of this decision and our support for all students, staff and faculty with disabilities. It signals our University's desire for inclusivity and shows another way that we're striving to make the university better every day.
